You are invited to submit a paper for the "13th EIEF-UNIBO-IGIER Bocconi Workshop on Industrial Organization" which will be held in Bologna at the Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna on December 19&20, 2024. The event is a joint initiative of the Bologna Center for Law and Economics (BCLE - University of Bologna), the Einaudi Institute for Economics and Finance (EIEF), and IGIER-Bocconi.

The workshop aims to strengthen the relationship between Italian economists working in the field of Industrial Organization, both in Italy and abroad, by bringing them together to discuss new research. In order to stimulate interaction, the program will consist of a small number of papers, which will be presented in a plenary session and ample time will be left for discussion and informal interaction. Contributions in both theoretical and empirical IO are welcome; we particularly encourage the submission of work in progress.

The **submission deadline** is **October 25**, **2024**, and final decisions on acceptance will be made by November 8, 2024. The organization will provide accommodation in Bologna for speakers but they will have to cover their own travel expenses.
