Rome, December 19&20, 2022

You are invited to submit a paper for the “*11th EIEF-UNIBO-IGIER Bocconi Workshop on Industrial Organization*” which will be held in Rome at the Einaudi Institute for Economics and Finance on December 19&20, 2022. The event is a joint initiative of the Bologna Center for Law and Economics (BCLE - University of Bologna), the Einaudi Institute for Economics and Finance (EIEF) and IGIER-Bocconi.

The workshop aims to strengthen the relationship between Italian economists working in the field of Industrial Organization, both in Italy and abroad, by bringing them together to discuss new research. In order to stimulate interaction, the program will consist of a small number of papers, which will be presented in a plenary session and ample time will be left for discussion and informal interaction. Contributions in both theoretical and empirical IO are equally welcome; we particularly encourage the submission of work in progress.

The **submission deadline** is **November 4, 2022** and final decisions on acceptance will be made by November 18, 2022. The organization will provide accommodation in Rome for speakers but they will have to cover their own travel expenses.
