The meeting aims at bringing together lead economists to discuss how the productive structure is reacting to the recent pandemic, energy and trade shocks, and the growing relevance of micro-macro interactions between public policies, firm choices, and aggregate productivity.

We welcome both theoretical and empirical works related (but not limited) to the following aspects:

- The effect of technology diffusion and firm innovation on welfare
- Firm-to-firm trade and production networks
- De-globalization, reshoring and the possible evolutions of global supply chains
- Management, firm organization and business crisis management
- The transition to net zero: implications for firm choices and public policy
- The design and distributional consequences of industrial policy in production networks
